Individual Participation and Contribution License Agreement

Thank you for your interest in becoming a code contributor ("**Contributor**") to The OpenSAF Foundation (the "**Foundation**") OpenSAF Code Project (the "**Project**"). In order to clarify the intellectual property license granted with Contributions from any person or entity, the Foundation must have a copy of this agreement (the "**Agreement**") on file that has been signed by each Contributor, indicating agreement to the license and other terms below. This Agreement is for your protection as a Contributor, as well as for the protection of the Foundation and the users of its software products; it does not change your rights to use your own Contributions for any other purpose. By signing and returning this Agreement, You accept and agree to the following:

A. To abide by the terms of all rules, policies and procedures of the Foundation as from time to time adopted by the Board of Directors of the Foundation (collectively, "**Policies**"). These Policies currently include the Bylaws, Operating Procedures, LGPL V 2.1 license, Technical Operating Procedures and Antitrust Policy. These rules, policies and procedures may be viewed and downloaded from our website www.opensaf.org

B. The terms and conditions for Your present and future Contributions submitted to the Foundation. The remaining terms of this Agreement constitute a license agreement between you as a Contributor and the Foundation, as the manager of the Project.

In return, the Foundation shall not use Your Contributions in a way that is contrary to the public benefit or inconsistent with its nonprofit status and bylaws as from time to time in effect. Except for the license and sublicense rights granted herein to the Foundation and to recipients of software distributed by the Foundation, You reserve all right, title, and interest in and to Your Contributions. Only Policies in effect at the time of a Contribution will apply to that Contribution.

1. Additional Definitions.

"You" (or "Your") shall mean the copyright owner or legal entity authorized by the copyright owner that is entering into this Agreement with the Foundation. For legal entities, the entity making a Contribution and all other entities that are controlled by that entity are considered to be a single Contributor. For the purposes of this definition, **"control"** means (i) the power, direct or indirect, to cause the direction or management of such entity, whether by contract or otherwise, or (ii) ownership of fifty percent (50%) or more of the outstanding shares, or (iii) beneficial ownership of such entity.

"Contribution" shall mean any original work of authorship, including any modifications or additions to an existing work, that is intentionally submitted by You to the Foundation for inclusion in, or documentation of, any of the software or other products owned or managed by the Foundation (the **"Work"**). For the purposes of this definition, **"submitted"** means the act of communicating any information, text, code or other data to the Foundation or its representatives by electronic, verbal, or written means, including but not limited to communications made on electronic mailing lists, source code control systems, and issue tracking systems that are managed by, or on behalf of, the Foundation for the purpose of discussing and improving a Work, but excluding communication that is conspicuously marked or otherwise designated in writing by You as "Not a Contribution."

2. Grant of Copyright License. Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, You hereby grant to the Foundation and to recipients of Works distributed by the Foundation a perpetual, worldwide, non-exclusive, no-charge, royalty-free, irrevocable copyright license to reproduce, prepare derivative works of, publicly display, publicly perform, sublicense, and distribute Your Contributions and such derivative works.

3. Grant of Patent License. Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, You hereby grant to the Foundation and to recipients of Works distributed by the Foundation a perpetual, worldwide, non-exclusive, no-charge, royalty-free, irrevocable (except as stated in this section) patent license to make, have made, use, offer to sell, sell, import, and otherwise transfer the Work, where such license applies only to those patent claims licensable by You that are necessarily infringed by Your Contribution(s) alone or by combination of Your Contribution(s) with the Work to which such Contribution(s) was submitted. If any entity institutes patent litigation against You or any other entity (including a cross-claim or counterclaim in a lawsuit) alleging that your Contribution, or the Work to which you have contributed, constitutes direct or contributory patent infringement, then any patent licenses granted to that entity under this Agreement for that Contribution or Work shall terminate as of the date such litigation is filed.

4. Representations. (a) You represent that you are legally entitled to grant the above license. If your employer(s) or any other person or entity (each a **"Third Party"**) has

rights to intellectual property that you create that includes your Contributions, you represent that you have received permission to make Contributions on behalf of that Third Party, that the Third Party has waived such rights for your Contributions to the Foundation, or that the Third Party has executed a separate CLA with the Foundation.

(b) You represent that each of Your Contributions is Your original creation (see section 6 for submissions on behalf of others). You represent that Your Contribution submissions include complete details of any third-party license or other restriction (including, but not limited to, related patents and trademarks) of which you are personally aware and which are associated with any part of Your Contributions. . You also represent that, except as so described, to your knowledge Your Contribution(s) will not necessarily infringe the patent claims of any third party (including any of Your Related Entities, as defined below), whether used or implemented alone or in combination with the Work to which such Contribution(s) was submitted. A Related Entity is any direct or indirect parent of You, and any entity Controlled by such a parent.

5. Disclaimers. The Foundation acknowledges and agrees that:

(a) You are not expected to provide support for Your Contributions, except to the extent You desire to provide support. You may provide support for free, for a fee, or not at all.

(b) Unless required by applicable law or agreed to in writing, You provide Your Contributions on an "AS IS" BASIS, WITHOUT WARRANTIES OR CONDITIONS OF ANY KIND, either express or implied, including, without limitation, any warranties or conditions of TITLE, NON-INFRINGEMENT, MERCHANTABILITY, or FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

6. Submission on Behalf of Others. Should You wish to submit Work that is not Your original creation, You may submit it to the Foundation separately from any Contribution, identifying the complete details of its source and of any license or other restriction (including, but not limited to, related patents, trademarks, and license agreements) of which you are personally aware, and conspicuously marking the Work as "Submitted on behalf of a third-party: [named here]".

7. Ongoing Information. You agree to notify the Foundation of any facts or circumstances of which you become aware that would make these representations inaccurate in any respect.

8. Choice of Law. This Agreement shall be subject to the federal laws of the United States of America and the state laws of the State of Delaware.
